Generosity of Raja Balwant Singh Ji

My Grand father Sheo Baran Singh was born around 1880 in village Baghai, situated in the princely state of Awagarh. His father, Th. Kalyan Singh, was a farmer, as had been his forefathers for many generations. He had his own land and a large family to support. Sheo Baran was his second son. The family was literate, but not formally educated. However, the young son showed an interest in learning and was taken by his father daily to the village teacher to study, reaching the teacher's home before sunrise. All his life he maintained that brahm muhurta was the best time to study. So he gained the rudiments of an education in Baghai, but for further studies, the nearest schools were in Agra. Fortunately, the Royal family of Awagarh, particularly our then Yuvraj Balwant Singh Saheb, was a votary of education, and, just at that time, he established a Rajput Hostel in Agra, in a place called Farzana Bagh. Some time in the late eighties, my grandfather went there and enrolled in Agra College. He stayed there till 1899, when he passed his Intermediate examination.

During one of his summer holidays, while my grandfather was at home, his father fell seriously ill and needed medical help. My grandfather walked in the searing heat to a neighbouring village to ask a vaidyaji for help, but the vaidyaji said he would come only in the evening when it was cooler. The heartbroken boy returned home, but on the way he vowed that he would become a doctor, and that he would never turn away from a cry for help. A difficult vow, from which he did not deviate.

When he had completed his Intermediate (with Pharsi as the primary language) and returned home, he broached his desire to his father, but they faced a problem: expense. There was no Medical college in what is now U.P. People from the Agra region went to Lahore to study medicine, and those from the Awadh region went to Calcutta. However, destiny smiled upon him.

Balwant Singh Saheb, the Yuvraj who had started the Rajput Hostel, had now become the Raja Saheb—Our Raja Saheb. He heard that a boy from his state had passed the Intermediate—which was not very common then—and summoned him to Awagarh. I will narrate the rest of the story as it was told to me by my grandfather, who always became very emotional when he recalled our Raja Saheb. Only one horse was available to our family, so Kalyan Singh Babaji, the father, rode on it, and Sheo Baran babaji, the son, walked behind him. They left well before sunrise on that summer day and reached Awagarh just as the sun was rising. Raja Saheb had come outside the gate, and was sitting under a tree supervising some construction work. His staff was with him. Baba Kalyan Singh ji approached him, paid his respects, and stated his name and that of his son. Raja Saheb spoke to them kindly and asked Sheo Baran Singh Babaji what he wanted to do, to which my grandfather replied that he wanted to go to Lahore to study medicine. Our Raja Saheb, acutely aware that this was beyond our family's means, turned immediately to one of his staff and ordered that a scholarship of Rs 2/- per month be paid to my grandfather for the entire duration of his medical studies. Such was our Raja Saheb's large heartedness. This scholarship enabled my grandfather to travel to Lahore and study in the medical college there, from where he graduated in 1905 and joined the Government Medical service. Rs 2/- of 1900 is equivalent to many thousands of rupees now—enough for travel, living expenses, and fees. Sheo Baran Singh babaji became a doctor, serving in many districts before retiring as a Civil Surgeon in 1936. His children and grandchildren were able to study and have done well in life, but Sheo Baran Singh babaji remained grateful to Raja Saheb all his life, and exhorted us to never forget that all this was due to the spontaneous generosity of our Raja Saheb. His one regret was that Raja Balwant Singh Saheb passed away at a young age and that my grandfather was not able to pay his respects often enough. In 1912, Sheo Baran Singh babaji got married. He was posted in Lakhimpur Kheri at that time, and the marriage took place in Hardoi. The baraat came mainly from his village, Baghai, via Tundla. Even so, the total expenses were less than four hundred rupees including travel, gifts for the bride and most important... Rs 50/- as donation to the Rajput College, which my grandfather considered his alma mater. At one time, he was the oldest living alumnus of the Rajput College. When my father, Dr. Rajendra Vir Singh, was teaching at the S N Medical College in Agra, he was associated with the management of the Rajput College. This was in the early 1950s. Dr. R K Singh was the Principal of the Rajput College at that time. So my affection for the RBS College, and respect for the Awagarh Royal family comes naturally. With all my heart, I wish that the College attain new heights of glory day on day in the future.

इसमें राव कृष्णपाल सिंह के लिए तो कहा ही क्या जाय ? वह आगरा की अपने समय की एक विभूति थे। विचारों में वह लिबरल पार्टी में शामिल थे। सेना में अवैतनिक अफसर, विरासत में पाई सैनिक शिक्षा की धरोहर, वैसा ही सुडौल लम्ब-तईंग शरीर और साफा की धज देखते ही लगता था, कोई नर शार्दूल चला आ रहा है-
“यथा मस्त गजयूथ में पंजानन चलि जाय।”

He could not go unnoticed in any place or society. Nature, had made him so. The six feet three inches height, shapely built] stately demeanour and elegantly dressed with safa as head & dress, separated him from the rest. Whether on parade] or in Basket Ball or Tennis Court, or on Horse back or on a Railway Platform or in the Lok Sabha, he stood out and was gazed at. This by itself, however] would not account for the deep love] profound respect and great admiration of the people for him nor would his achievements in life.

What did distinguished him from the rest to earn a place in the category of unforgettable was the style of his life. In fact it is this which explains the gap between what he achieved and what he could have achieved. Another trait of his] which stands out was unfailing courtesy uniformly extended to every one according to his due] not as Rao Sahib conceived but as by the recipient.

The last but more important than what has preceded was his spirit of self & denial, a complete disregard of his personal interest. This is exemplified by his role in getting the Awagarh Estate declared impartible. The Awagarh Estate was the largest in Agra part of the erstwhile United Provinces of Agra and Oud. The legal status of the Estate] whether it was partible, was not defined- Rao Sahib was the second son of the late Raja Balwant Singh Ji. In the event of the Estate being declared partible, he would have been the owner of half the Estate. There was all round pressure on him to start legal proceeding to this end. Even the district judge of Agra Mr. P. C. Planders suggested to me to induce Rao Sahib to move in the matter. I told him that the affairs of the Awagarh Estate were no concern of mine. Not only Rao Sahib did not succumb to the temptation] when an opportunity was provided by others, he deposed before a Law Court that the Estate was impartible. He alone was capable of passing a self & denying ordinance of this nature. He was by far the greatest gentleman, I have met in life. May others follow in his foot & steps.

स्वर्गीय राव कृष्णपाल सिंह एक अनुभवी, दूरदर्शी और विवेकशील व्यक्ति थे। साथ ही एक सरल, सौम्य और प्रभावोत्पादक व्यक्तित्व के धनी थे। अपनी इन विशेषताओं के कारण वे अत्यन्त लोकप्रिय बन गये थे। संक्रमण काल में तथा देश के स्वतंत्र होने के पश्चात् उन्होंने अपने कई मित्र नरेशों को देश और समाज के हित में परामर्श दिया। उनकी सामयिक और समुचित मंत्रणाओं के कारण कई राजे-महाराजे उनके प्रति आदर की भावना रखते थे।

राव साहब का अनुकरणीय भ्रातृ-प्रेम भी चिरस्मरणीय रहेगा। अपने अग्रज राजा साहब सूर्यपाल सिंह जी, अवागढ़ के जीवन के उत्तरार्ध के समय उन्होंने जो निष्कपट और अगाध स्नेह तथा सौहार्द्र निभाया, वह अनुकरणीय है।

श्री राव साहब का स्वभाव सरल और विनम्र, हृदय महान् उदार एवं पर दुःख से द्रवीभूत होने वाला था। कोई भी कभी उनके पास जाता तो स्वयं अपने आसन से उठकर प्रेमपूर्वक हँसते हुए आगन्तुक का स्वागत करते थे और बड़ी मधुर हास्य रस से परिपूरित वाणी से वार्त्तालाप करते थे। इस रसास्वादन के लिए हम उनके दर्शन और सम्पर्क के लिए उत्सुक रहते थे और समय-समय पर बिना किसी कार्य के ही उनसे भेंट करने जाया करते थे।

“आवत ही भेंटे ललकि, नैनन भरे सनेह।
बिना बुलाए जाइये, ता प्रेमी के गेह”

कोई भी किसी भी कार्य हेतु उनके पास गया कभी विमुख नहीं लौटा। सभी की यथेष्ट सहायता सिफारिश करने में उनको प्रसन्नता होती थी। श्री राव साहब देश-भक्ति और देश-सेवा में पूरा समय देते थे।

श्री उलफत सिंह चौहान ‘निर्भय’ (स्वतंत्रता सेनानी)

यथार्थ में स्व. राव साहब जैसे देव-पुरुषों की यथागाथा स्वतः ही उनके कार्यों के कारण अमर होती है और उसके चरितार्थ करने हेतु किसी अतिरिक्तमानवीय प्रयासों की आवश्यकता नहीं होती। इस प्रकार के देव-पुरुषों की किसी भी कसौटी पर स्व. राव साहब का व्यक्तित्व और तित्त्व पूर्णतः खरा उतरा है।

अन्य अनेक मानवीय गुणों के साथ राव साहब महाराज में कितनी बारीक साहित्यिक पैठ थी, इसका केवल एक प्रमाण दूँगा। बात 1934 की है- गंगाधर शास्त्री हॉल (आगरा कॉलेज) में शंकरुण रस दिवस था। अध्यक्ष के आसन पर स्वर्गीय राव साहब थे। अनेक विद्यार्थियों ने शंकरुण रस का कविता पाठ किया था। प्रथम पुरस्कार श्री श्याम मुरारी चतुर्वेदी को दिया गया था। समारोह के समापन पर अपने अध्यक्षीय भाषण में राव साहब ने जो मौके की बात इंगित की कि बहुत से कविता पाठकों ने दर्द भरा काव्य सुनाया पर किसी ने भी आगरा के ही करुण-रस के मुख्य कवि सत्यनारायण कविरल की कोई कविता नहीं सुनाई। अपने ही करुण कवि की यह उपेक्षा सहनीय नहीं होनी चाहिए

राव साहब महाराज की बात बिल्कुल सही थी। हम सभी कविता पढ़ने वाले इस कमी और तथ्य उजागरण से न केवल अचंभित थे बल्कि शर्मिन्दा भी थे। ऐसी पैनी साहित्यिक दृष्टि थी राव साहब की।

Dr. R.K. Singh I Knew

It was a fortunate day in 1965 when Dr. R. K. Singh and his family arrived in Gary, Indiana] on a fulbright year to interpret India for the school children in Gary. Actually, his mission took him and his wife, Suraj, not only to some forty schools in Gary but to countless colleges, churches, women's groups] and service clubs all over the state of Indiana and several neighboring states.

The social studies curriculum in Indiana had just been revised to require a course in the Non & Western World at the seventh grade level- The title indicates our ethnocen & tricity, but Indiana was a leader in the U.S. in establishing a required course on Asia and Africa. At that time there were major problems ¼ especially in the lack of adequate textbooks and knowledgeable teachers and in the inaccuracies and stereotypes that abounded at the time.

Dr. Singh and his family brought India to life- He took time to develop a curriculum guide and provided a series of essays on India which were used as reading materials. He talked to all the seventh grade children in the city and met many high school and college assemblies. Mrs. Singh visited many elementary schools. She radiated skill and charm. It was not unusual to see little eight and ten year old students going home at lunch time in Indian sarees, to show their parents.

As their circles widened to include adult groups, the Singhs graciously entertained in their apartment, Many people still remember the delicious Indian food and the interesting discussions in their home.

Dr. Singh was devoted to India and interpreted it well. At one time when he visited the campus of Indiana University in Bloomington] the professors and scholars from India who were on the campus were invited to meet with him. It was impressive group. Toward the end of his talk, Dr. Singh looked at them quizzically and said, "Let me put to you a question. Why is it that you are not offering your services, your skills and talents to your country India\" There was varied answers; some were embarrassed; some indicated their intention to return. Dr. Singh's deep understanding of and feelings for India were apparent in everything he said and did during that fulbright year.

When I visited India in 1974 on a Fulbright program for school administrators, I found all over India that to mention the name of Dr. R. K. Singh was to open many doors- I'll never forget our walks in the hills of Himachal Pradesh where he was at that time, the Vice Chancellor of the University, the visit to a mushroom farm on the way to Agra, the tree at the college and my first visit to the Taj Mahal at night with Mrs. Singh as my guide.

Ten years later at the time of the assassination of Madame Gandhi, I was a guest in the Singh home in Agra. Dr. Singh was up at dawn working in his garden the parrots fluttered around the patio as Dr. Singh and his colleagues consider that week one of the most worthwhile and interesting of my life.

As one of the hundreds of people whom Dr. Singh has touched I miss him. I miss his gentleness, his understanding, his feeling for people. There is much I would like to ask him. I wish he could once more put to me a question.

At the time of Dr. Singh's visit, I was the social studies and foreign language supervisor of the Mary Schools and an Adjunct Associate Professor of Indiana University, North West.
